-  **A feather** - any size, any color

-  **Something smooth** - smoother than a regular rock
-  **Something rough** - bark, pinecone, or dried grass
-  **2 different birds** - different species, not just two of the same
-  **A cloud that looks like something** - agree on what it looks like
-  **Water** - puddle, stream, pond, or fountain
-  **Something blooming** - flower, bud, or any plant in color
-  **A squirrel or chipmunk** - watch it for 10 seconds before checking
-  **A stick taller than the youngest person**
-  **One thing nobody else spotted** - your secret find of the day

GRANDPARENT TIP

Most county parks are free on weekdays - parking is the main cost, and many lots have no attendant before 9am. Free ranger programs run most weekends at state parks; check the DEC or DEEP calendar before you go.
